1. Welcome

2. Principal Report

Dr. McElligot reported:

- a. The Eighth Grade Graduation plan is in its final stages. Wood Oaks hopes to communicate the plan soon.
- b. Wood Oaks is still formalizing the plan for removing students' belonging from the school and returning materials to the school. The process will take place by grade level on June 3, 4 and 5 between 2 and 6 pm. No time slots will be assigned. Families can drive up on their designated day any time during the window. Stations will likely be set up around the building for drop off and pick up. Wearing of masks will be requested. A detailed communication will hopefully be circulated by the end of the week.
- c. The last instructional day will be Friday, May 29. June 1 and 2 are part of calendar, but the kids will do fun activities. The staff is working to put together a virtual Field Day for June 1. The students will attend school for 3 hours (8-11 a.m.) on Tuesday, June 2. No firm plan yet, but students may wrap up to the year with their home rooms.
- d. The District is taking its guidance from Governor Pritzker in terms of school re-opening in the Fall. When the school re-opens, there will be restrictions set in place, including restrictions on the number of students in the building.

- b. 2019-2020 PTA Gift: The PTA purchased musical instruments for the music department.
 Dr. Olson is working with Wood Oaks music teacher to develop a curriculum for next year.
