Dr. McElligott reported:

- a. The shift back from the adaptive pause to hybrid learning was successful. 11 students who were fully remote are now participating remotely. 85-90 students remain fully remote.
- b. Conferences went well. Both the teachers and parents said the Zoom meetings went smoothly. Discussions in the future as to whether conferences should continue to be virtual.
- c. Finals of school-wide spelling bee. Isaac M., a 6th grader, was the champion of the school-wide spelling bee. The semi-finalist was 7th grader.
- d. Terra Nova testing is going on this week. It is an on-line test. Although it is a shorter test, it will provide data that can be compared to past years. The test will be given in person Wednesday and Thursday. Fully remote students are invited to come in on Friday (a non-student attendance day) to take the test.
- e. PBIS: All ROARS are electronic. All students and staff can go to the website and deliver an e-ROAR. In January, there was a push for teachers to put out additional ROARs. In last announcement, the students were encouraged to send to each other.
- f. Yearbook photos are still being collected and should be sent to Ms. Reap or Ms. Olesuk by March 15. We are looking for a blend of in-school and at home school photos.
